

SUBJECT: Delegation of Dual Compensation Waiver Authority

1. Reference: Memorandum, Office of the Assistant Secretary of Army (Manpower and Reserve Affairs), 19 September 2001, Personnel Issues Related to Attacks on the World Trade Center and the Pentagon - Appointment Authorities and Policy Waivers.
2. In response to the 11 September 2001 attacks, the Office of Personnel Management has authorized the use of temporary excepted service appointments for one year when needed to support rescue, recovery, investigation, military support and other directly related functions. This authority can be used to hire former Federal employees, some of whom may be receiving an annuity. You are delegated authority to waive dual compensation reductions on a case-by-case basis, and may redelegate this authority in writing to subordinate commanders and activity heads. A waiver can only be authorized to those former Federal employees who are appointed under the special excepted service authority in response to the attacks, and cannot exceed 30 September 2002. You are responsible for maintaining the records required by the Office of Personnel Management on each waiver of dual compensation reductions that is approved.
