

## USACE Civilian Drug Testing Program

Executive Order 12564 established the requirement that the "...Federal Government, as the largest employer in the nation, can and should show the way towards achieving drug-free workplaces through a program designed to offer drug users a helping hand and at the same time demonstrating to drug users that drugs will not be tolerated in the Federal workplace."

USACE drug testing services are performed under an interagency agreement with the National Business Center, Department of Interior. The agreement allows USACE to use the contracts negotiated by NBC, DOI.
