2. We have been approved to deploy subject system and will commence with the Washington Aqueduct followed by Baltimore District. This deployment will also serve as SAT for APPMS. We have coordinated with the following dates with your logistics offices to install and instruct your users on the program:

During this time, purchase requests for property will not be processed through CEFMS. All other functions in CEFMS will not be effected. Users of the software will be asked to provide comments, and we will closely monitor its progress for several weeks. The evaluation period may be extended if unidentified problems with the system are encountered. You will be notified of our progress.

3. The new version of APPMS, has features that will reduce interface problems with CEFMS, increase reliability, and make it accessible with a web browser.
4. We will have programmers, functionals, and Program Manager on site during the test.
