
MEMORANDUM FOR SEE DISTRIBUTION

SUBJECT: Reporting of Historical Analysis Generator (HAG) Data

1. In accordance with ER 1110-3-1300, Military Programs Cost Engineering, paragraph 20 (web page <http://www.usace.army.mil/inet/usace-docs/eng-regs/er1110-3-1300/toc.htm>), the PDT (cost engineer) is mandated to report the awarded cost data into HAG within 30 days from the date of MILCON construction contract award. This should be identified as a Project Management Plan activity and the project managers are responsible to assure that the data is reported on time. In the past several years, there has been minimal response. The lack of support from MSC's and their districts has reached a critical level in maintaining a feasible and meaningful database.
2. This cost data reporting is essential in updating of unit prices for the Department of Defense (DoD) facilities construction cost guidance. Once the HAG cost data from the three services is consolidated into the DoD Military Facility Cost Guide, the DoD Comptroller uses the data to evaluate the project funding before submitting to Congress for construction budget. Therefore, cost data must be complete and reliable, as the data is the source for establishing the construction funding for future DoD Military Construction projects.
3. Input to HAG is simple and requires little time to fill in about forty blocks of data for each project for new MILCON construction. The cost data must be reviewed/validated by the MSC cost engineer before uploading to HAG 2.1 software. The HAG software and user's manual are available for downloading from the Tri-Service Cost Engineering System (TRACES) web page (<http://www.hnd.usace.army.mil/traces/whats-new.asp>).
